Miguel Ángel Lázaro Díaz was born in 1989 in Madrid, where he started his musical training at the age of 7 with the Korean teacher Jose Lee. Subsequently, he studied with Miguel Santaolalla and Carlos Ramos. He was admitted in the class of the guitarist and composer Jorge de Carlos in 2005. He finished his studies with the best results and received an honorary award for it, consisting of an invitation to give both concerts at Auditorio Nacional de Madrid and Real Casa de la Moneda.

He started his degree at the Real Conservatorio Superior de Música de Madrid in 2007, where he took lessons with professor Manuel Estevez. Miguel earned an Erasmus scholarship which allowed him to study in Düsseldorf (Germany) at Robert Schumann School with the renowned Cuban professor Joaquin Clerch. He attended several masterclasses with renowned artists. Miguel performed at different venues such as the Ateneo de Madrid, Casa Regional Vasca, Casa Regional Canaria, General Consulate of Spain in Düsseldorf, and at the Spanish Consulate in Seul (Korea) to perform as a soloist. In 2017 he toured in China with his colleague and guitarist Manni Wu.

He has collaborated at the Seoul Guitar Festival (Korea) both as a soloist and as a member of the jury of the Guitar National Competition that was held simultaneously. One of his performances was broadcasted by Radio Nacional de España. In 2009 Miguel gave a charity concert for helping children in Cameroon. Likewise, he was finalist of the International Contest Norba Caeserina in 2011 and 2012. Both in 2013 and 2015 he was awarded a scholarship by the DAAD in Düsseldorf.
