1. REINA SOFÍA SCHOOL OF MUSIC

Since **2017**, the School offers summer programmes for youths up to 18 years-old.

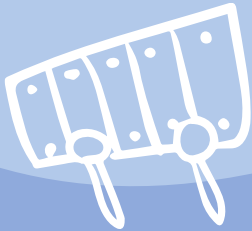


Both programmes are available in full board (all-inclusive accommodation) or day campus.

- It combines personalized instrumental learning with activities and workshops that provides vital skills for building an artist in the classical music world



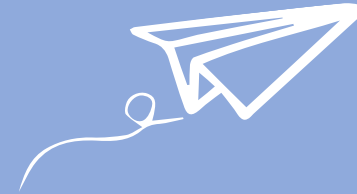

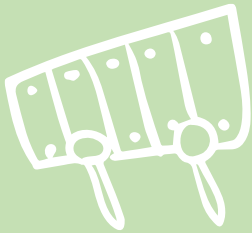

- **Residence** just 10 minutes by bus from the Conservatoire. Services provided are:

 - Cleaning service, bedsheets and towels changes, and laundry one a week
 - Classrooms

6. MONITORS AND PROFESSORS

- Summer Camp **teachers** are last year's students at Reina Sofía School or alumni working professionals, all of them selected following the School academic criteria.
- **Free-time instructors**, one every six/seven participants, all of them certified Leisure and Free Time instructors, accompany and organize the students' activities to make them feel at home.



7. COMMUNICATION WITH THE FAMILIES

SUMMER CAMP TELEGRAM CHANNEL

A few days before the start we will open a direct communication channel with the families through the Telegram app. Here we will be sharing all the relevant information needed for the correct development of the programme, and a daily overview that includes pictures of the activities that took place.

DIRECT CONTACT

We suggest to have the first contact between families and full board students the third day of the programme, being this period a recommendation to allow the children to reach the best possible levels of adaptation and learning. During the programme, we suggest evenings once the lessons are over and the students have time to shower as the best time to communicate directly with your kids.

CELL PHONES

Participants are allowed to bring their cell phones to the camp. It is not permitted to use cell phones during lessons and activities.
